DYNAMOS Ages 8 to 10	<ul> <li>ALL equipment is provided</li> <li>Please wear sensible sports shoes and clothing—ideally the Dynamos shirt or a white T shirt or polo shirt</li> </ul>
PAIRS CRICKET Ages 10 to 11	<ul> <li>ALL equipment provided including helmets EXCEPT</li> <li>Boys MUST have and wear their own abdominal protector (also known as a 'cricket box'), which is best held in place by a pair of box briefs with a pouch.</li> <li>Please wear sensible sports shoes and clothing—ideally a white T shirt or polo shirt.</li> </ul>

Some children in Pairs Cricket may start to acquire their own kit such as a bat, pads, gloves or a helmet. If you require any guidance, please speak to a coach or ensure you only buy from a reputable supplier who can give good sizing advice. Buying the wrong size bat can lead to a really poor technique, for example.

We also run a Development XI on a Sunday to help juniors transition from midweek games to the longer form, played at weekends.
